
Animal Sciences

- Animal Sciences offers 5 options which allow students to specialize, however students are not required to choose an option. The options are <u>Animal Behavior</u>, <u>Animal BioHealth/Pre-Professional</u>, <u>Animal Production</u>, <u>Equine</u>, and <u>Rangeland Science</u>. - Level 100/200 and lower division Baccalaureate Core are priority courses to complete before transferring to OSU.
- For Animal Science students, the best time to transfer is Fall term, particularly due to the Animal Sciences series courses. Talk with an OSU advisor about your specific timeline.
