The Local Food Safety Collaborative invites you to a virtual discussion on PFAS, also known as "forever chemicals" with Dr. Cheryl Murphy on December 4th at 12:00 PM EST (9 AM PT).

PFAS or perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances are a class of manmade chemical compounds known to resist degradation, making them a harmful threat to human health and the environment. Dr. Cheryl Murphy is a distinguished professor in the Department of Fisheries and Wildlife at Michigan State University and currently leads the Center for PFAS Research. During this hour-long discussion, Dr. Murphy will dissect the long-term problems these widely used chemicals present and what they mean for agriculture and food safety.
